On drop-in days we will have more traffic on-site and we will be limiting attendance to no more than 50 people in an outdoor gathering as per up-to-date COVID protocols.

### COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

We will be practicing contact-tracing as well as taking sanitization measures and other COVID precautions on-site. If you are feeling ill or having any covid19 related symptoms, we ask that you stay home to take care and rest. It's really important to stay hydrated and be aware of our bodies' wellness throughout camp.

If you are not adequately vaccinated, have travelled outside the region, or are able to, we recommend you get tested before your arrival at camp.

Please make sure to sign in everyday before we start to work on the hides.

When you are finished with a tool, please disinfect it before you pass it to someone else to prevent cross-contamination.

We are in the fourth wave of the pandemic, it is crucial to wear your mask at all times to protect each other. We will have hand sanitizer, masks and latex gloves available.
